Make visiting your library a regular part of your week. Ask about Rhyme Time and Story Time sessions too!

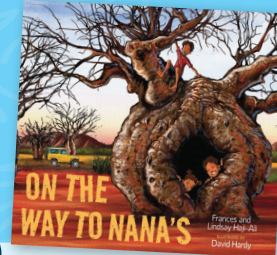
Ask questions and model inquisitive behaviour when you read with your child. This will further develop their curiosity and understanding of the world.
